
WHY IS CREDIBILITY IMPORTANT?

- people rarely buy a online product/service from someone that they do not know anything about
- your website, social media profiles (professional purposes only) and images give you credibility
- It can also be built by associating yourself with others (e.g. guest blog posts like TESL Ontario)
- the importance of testimonials (experts, peers, clients, students, parents)




